Syllables division: (provisions) ① Two consonant letters or groups, one before, one after. For example: let-ters mem-ber chil-dren. A consonant letter or group, after. For example: pa-pers stu-dents stu-dy. Open syllables: (rules) ① Syllables with no consonant groups after a single vowel. For example: no by stu-dent. After a single vowel, add a single consonant, and then add a syllable of the silent letter e. Name these. Closed syllable: (specified) A syllable ending in consonant letter(except r, w, y). For example: hot egg dog. According to the phonological method of fang, we have worked out this scheme. ① Study and master nine steps: Leave,divide,combine,open,close,non-default labels,mix labels,stress,root, you can read correctly.
